Dear Parents/Carers of Macaw class,

Welcome to the new school year! We hope you all had a great break, and we're very happy to welcome you and your child into their new class. Our overall topic for the first half term is: Central and South America. Many aspects of the curriculum will be linked to this topic.

English

The children will write their own adventure story based in the history and culture of the Maya civilisation. They will also write a diary from the perspective of the protagonist of Holes, our wholeclass text.

Maths

Our focus in Maths will be Number: determining place value, multiples of 1,000 up to 1,000,000, times tables and measurement.

Science

We will be growing our knowledge of life processes and cycles for plants and animals. We will also be spending this term learning about and using the processes involved in computing and online collaboration.

Art/Music/Dance/Drama

We will explore a variety of creative and expressive arts: we will be getting our dancing shoes on, delving into Latin American dance and having a go at the samba! In music, we're going to learn about rock music by listening to Bon Jovi's Livin' On A Prayer.

History/Geography

This autumn term we will be learning about we will be looking at the Maya and the continent of South America, taking a turn as investigators of human and physical geography.

PSHME

We will discuss and learn about respecting ourselves and others, focussing on our rights, discrimination and prejudice.

RE

Year 5 will be learning about Islam, with a focus on Ramadan and Eid al-Fitr.

ICT

Computing will have a focus on computer systems and how to collaborate online. We will also be looking at what makes healthy friendships, both in person and online.

MFL

Children will revisit Spanish numbers and learn adjectives: colour and shape, and animals.

P.E.

We will keep ourselves active and develop key movement and handeye co-ordination skills with weekly sessions of netball, basketball and the Daily Mile.
