Reminder - No Dogs in School

The Brindishe Federation does not allow dogs on its premises. This means that dogs must not be brought onto any part of the school grounds.

Bringing dogs onto the premises could pose a health and safety risk to our children and families, and could be unsettling for many as they arrive and leave school. This includes Brindishe Breakfast Club and Tea Club. There are added risks of dogs fouling, or showing aggressive, unpredictable behaviour.

The only exception are registered dogs for the visually or hearing impaired. Under the Equality Act 2010, if the owner has a disability, they are allowed to bring their guide dog onto the school site.
