What has been happening this week?

Summer term updates

As we move towards the summer term, I wanted to remind parents and carers about what children can and can't wear in school.



- Please make sure children have layers for colder mornings and warmer afternoons, making sure that all clothing is clearly labelled.
- Please have sun hats ready for when the weather gets warmer and apply sun screen before school, at home.
- Please be reminded that children should **not** wear open-toed sandals, to prevent injury.
- Children should **not** wear crocs in school, they do not support a child's ankle and foot well enough for running/ playtimes.
- If your child is wearing a 'playsuit' or dungarees, please make sure they are able to get these on and off easily when using the toilet.

Children should **not** wear jewellery to school, this can get caught whilst the children are playing and cause accidents.

Educational Visits

Each year we try our best to make sure that children have experiences outside of the classroom, linked to their learning. Teachers plan educational trips in the most cost effective way possible.

We have seen a decrease in the number of families paying for trips and visitors to school. If we can not cover the cost of trips, then we will not be able to run them in the future.

Please make sure you make payment for your child's school trip when you give permission. You can also go back and make payment for trips you have not already paid for. This supports our school budget and prevents us cancelling future planned visits.

How to book activities


Families who receive benefit related free school meals will have received a HAF (Holiday Activities and Food)
